Common Wood Horse Rider Permit Application Form

Penn & Tylers Green Residents Society



The Penn and Tylers Green Residents Society (PTGRS) is a registered charity which purchased the majority of Common Wood in 2003.

At that time a riding permit scheme was in operation administered by the Penn Area Bridleway Association and this was continued under the new ownership.

A key requirement was that riders were members of PABA who would administer the permit scheme on behalf of P&TGRS.

As from 1st January 2020 membership of PABA is no longer a requirement, however riders will hold their own third party insurance and will indemnify P&TGRS against all claims arising from their use of Common Wood. P&TGRS will not accept any responsibility for the safety of any rider when riding in Common Wood.

Permits will be issued directly by P&TGRS.

The fee of £35.00 has remained unchanged since before 2003. The fees are used toward maintaining the wood. Much of this is carried out by volunteers and riders are welcome to contribute their effort. To be kept abreast of volunteer activities send an email to commonwoodvolunteer@gmail.com

A permit gives access to over 250 acres of traffic free semi-natural ancient woodland with over four miles of hardened tracks designated and maintained for all-weather horse riding . There is almost the same length of side tracks which may be accessed when firm and dry, however they may not be trimmed back for horse riders.

Riders should familiarise themselves with the wood and a leaflet is available at the main entrance in Common Wood Lane or at <https://commonwood.pennandtylersgreen.org.uk/walks/>

Please respect the private areas to the North and West which are not part of the scheme. There are also permissive rides on the neighbouring Penn House Estate and a map is available from their website <http://www.pennhouse.org.uk/walks/walks.htm>

Each permit holder will be provide with a disc, which may be attached to your saddle, bridle or tabard, but must be with you at all times when you are riding in Common Wood. A sticker showing the year for which the permit is valid will be supplied with your disc and on renewal.

You may be asked by wardens to show your permit. Please do not be offended if you are asked to leave the wood because you are unable to produce a current permit.

Under the scheme each horse and rider in the wood must be in possession of a current permit disc.

Access to the woods and tracks is permissive. From time to time there may be a need to close off areas or trails for safety, works or maintenance. Please obey any signs or instructions.

The Riding Code:

Be polite friendly and courteous to other woodland users. When approaching from behind do not assume they know you are there– call ahead to warn of your presence. Carry your permit at all times riding when in the wood Report any problems to the wood manager as soon as possible
